Concerning your inquiry regarding which features could be eliminated from the submitted receiver in order for it to <u>not</u> be considered a firearm, to preclude a classification as a firearm receiver per GCA provisions, the following machining operations must be left unaccomplished:

- Hammer opening (bottom).
- Magazine-well opening (bottom).
- Holes for trigger-housing alignment pins (bottom).
- Ejection ports (left and right).
- Hole for barrel stop-pin (top).
- Barrel-nut threads (forward).
- Receiver-extension threads (rear).

However, the following machining operations <u>may be implemented</u> on the unfinished receiver without it being classified as a "firearm":

- Cocking slot opening.
- Holes for accessory rails.
